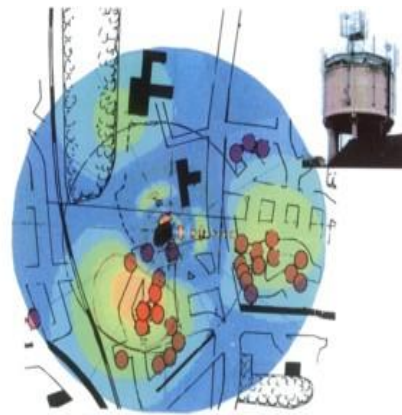




Radio Frequency Radiation is a relatively new environmental pollution that has increased exponentially since the birth of the mobile phone and wireless communications in general but in particular during the last five years. The rate of its expansion has far outstripped any regulatory body's attempt (which have been little if any) to understand its affects upon humans and with government and mobile phone operators repeatedly referring to flawed guidelines (ICNIRP) which originated shortly after the war and were based on thermal effects and therefore have no relevance to the biological effects of modern wireless communications. Leading health experts around the world battle governments who possibly influenced by tax dollars/pounds and potential further economic damage won't hear the bad news that the largest producer of this new environmental pollution mobile phone masts are actually lethal and even insignificant exposure to digital wireless technologies can and almost will cause one, some or all of the following in time:

- Nausea
- Headaches/Migraine

- Circulatory problems
- Little or no immunity
- Nose bleeds

Above you can see a phone mast and the graphic shows the cancer clusters in orange situated in the points of maximum intensity of signal from the mast. These levels are far beyond the norm for cancer in the UK today to such a degree that the odds of the connection between the tower and the illness would seem to be beyond doubt. It is the author's opinion that this scenario, should studies be conducted be the norm around most if not all phone masts that have been in situ in residential areas for seven years or more.

Obviously these are this author's views but the Government's own Sir William Stewart and even the WHO suggest we should operate a precautionary principle to this technology which is being completely ignored by the phone operators and governments alike.
